Definitions

- **AMT (Advanced Ministry Training):** Five – Eight week-long elective courses that give students training in a variety of areas (e.g. missions, prophetic art, evangelism, dance, intimacy with God, Hosting His Presence. God’s Glory, mentoring, other Bible lessons etc).
- **Corporate Prayer & Worship:** Before class starts, students gather to pray and worship.
- **Bible:** This time is divided up between significant Bible teachers - covering Bible exegesis, Kingdom Foundations and Survey of the Bible.
- **Speaker:** Staff speakers or guest speakers teach during this time. Teaching is most effective when it is partnered with activation. We activate our students in what they learn as much as possible.
- **Worship:** A scheduled student worship team leads in corporate worship – this helps develop new and up and coming talent.
- **Break:** Students are released for lunch and short afternoon breaks between sessions.
- **City Service:** Students are sent out to do community outreach; activating the supernatural gifts they have learned throughout the week and transforming our city.
- **Revival Groups:** Students numbers divided into two groups for community, accountability, activation and impartation.
- **Small Groups:** Revival Groups are further divided into smaller groups of 5 – 8 students with a connect group leader.
- **LOOC:** Once a month Revival Groups will join with our local City Council to *Love On Our City*.
- **All-In Hour (Wednesday):** These meetings are significant and are aimed at creating an opportunity to rub shoulders with Glow Core Team and leaders of Glow Church. Attendance is compulsory and does influence graduation.
- **Sunday Service:** Students are required to SERVE at one service per weekend and SIT AND RECEIVE in one service per weekend. This will count towards students graduating.
